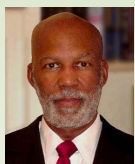
A LIVE ZOOM VIRTUAL EVENT

Terrence J. Roberts, Ph.D. is one of the "Little Rock Nine" who desegregated Central High School in Little Rock, Arkansas in 1957. As a 15 year old eleventh grader, he joined eight other students and became one of the first nine black students to go to a formerly segregated public high school in Little Rock. Dr. Roberts is CEO of Terrence Roberts Consulting, a management consultant firm devoted to fair and equitable practices in business and industry. Additionally, he is co-principal of Roberts & Roberts, LLC, a consulting firm offering assistance to groups who wish to engage in substantive conversations about race and the issues related to race in America. A graduate of California State University at Los Angeles (BA), and UCLA (MSW), Dr. Roberts obtained his Ph.D. in Psychology from Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Illinois.



Delores B. Lindsey, Ph.D. retired as Associate Professor of Education at California State University San Marcos, but did not retire from the education profession. As a former teacher, site administrator and county office administrator, Delores is well-known nationally and specifically in the north county area as coauthor of numerous books on Cultural Proficiency.



Randall B. Lindsey, Ph.D., coauthor of numerous books on Cultural Proficiency, is Emeritus Professor at California State University, Los Angeles. He has served as a teacher, an administrator, executive director of a non-profit corporation, and served as administrator at Redlands University and California Lutheran University.
