Dr. Franklin CampbellJones works closely with schools and educational systems assisting them with applying the tenets of cultural proficiency to their policies and practices to ensure establishment and maintenance of equitable learning environments for children. He has served as teacher, professor, school administrator, district office director, and state director for the California School Leadership Academy.



Dr. Trudy T. Arriaga served as the first female superintendent of the Ventura Unified School District for 14 years. Her journey toward the role of superintendent included trilingual paraeducator, teacher, assistant principal, principal, and director. Dr. Arriaga has focused her life work on the fundamental belief that the educational system has tremendous capability and responsibility to open doors for all students.



Dr. Delores B. Lindsey retired as Associate Professor of Education at California State University San Marcos, but did not retire from the education profession. As a former teacher, site administrator and county office administrator, Delores is well-known nationally and specifically in the north county area as coauthor of numerous books on Cultural Proficiency.



Dr. Randall B. Lindsey, coauthor of numerous books on Cultural Proficiency, is Emeritus Professor at California State University, Los Angeles. He has served as a teacher, an administrator, executive director of a non-profit corporation, and served as administrator at Redlands University and California Lutheran University.
